#### What's in the Workshop

**Grant Writing 101** - begins with an overview of some grant basics, including project descriptions and budgets. The main focus is an in depth look at how grants are adjudicated (or selected) by having workshop participants play the role of a selection jury, based on assessing applications to a fictional provincial funding program. Participants gain an understanding of how funding applications are received and assessed, using a model that is commonly used by a wide range of agencies

**Grant Writing 201** - covers the various kinds of funding opportunities, including local, municipal, regional, provincial and national sources. Each type of funding has different requirements. Managing successful grants and final reporting are covered. Participants have the opportunity to write and critique sample applications, and go over various ways to present their ideas in response to the requirements of various types of funding currently available, especially federal government programs
